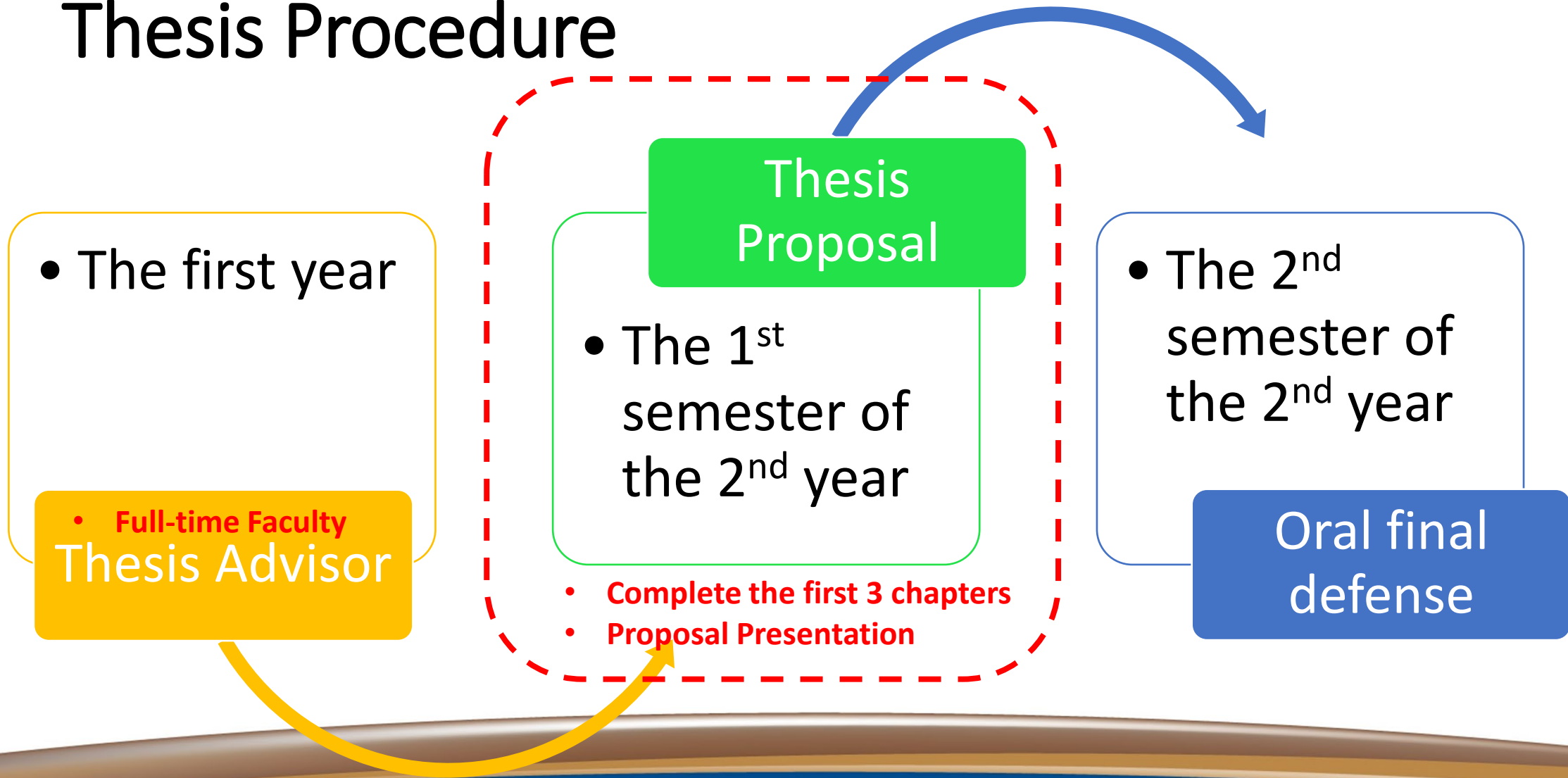

Thesis Requirement

- Graduation thesis must be submitted to a seminar or conference in school or off-campus before graduation.
- The thesis credits will be approved after receiving thesis acceptance certificate.

Academic Research Ethics Course (Online)

- 6 hours course
- After course exam
(Your grade needs to reach 85 or higher)
- Must finish it for graduation
